Great Expectations by Evan Kramer

Congratulations to the newly installed officers of the Port Orford Chamber of Commerce and Port Orford's new council members who all took office this past Monday. Last week we asked the Chamber to "go for it" concerning the circus and on Monday they agreed to sponsor their performances in this town. This is a new year and it's good to see there are people who want to get involved.

It's almost hard to believe there's yet another election right around the corner. There was enough going on with the November, 1992 election that it seemed like we all needed a rest. There is an election here in Curry County on March 23. The voting will be conducted by mail in ballots (better sign your own ballot). So you don't have to know which precinct you reside in or where to go to vote on the 23rd. This election is for the purpose of electing more than 100 officers to the 52 special districts within the County. Just look on your over-inflated property tax bill and you'll see some of them listed. The ones you pay for are the ones you vote in. Library district, rural fire district, Curry Health District, port district, cemetery district, school district, red light district... The local 2CJ school district is the only one in Curry County that extends into Coos County and includes about 400 voters from that county. The only taxing district which doesn't have an elected board is the 4H-Extension Service.

There are two openings on the library board, three on the rural fire board, two on the port district and two on the 2CJ school district in the Port Orford area. Now if you want to run for one of these positions it's fairly easy. You need to journey down to the county courthouse in Gold Beach and walk down the stairs to the basement to the elections department. Rene Kolen was recently elected County Clerk and has moved upstairs into that office. Julie Denney is pow rurning the

elections office. She's very helpful and will provide you with the paperwork you'll need. She can be reached at 1-800-634-1147 - then ask for the elections department. There are two ways to get on the ballot. One is to fill out the paperwork and pay a \$10 fee. The other is to fill out the paperwork and collect the valid signatures of 25 voters residing within the district you'll be running in. At this point if you're interested in being elected you're running out of time so pay the \$10. The last day to submit your name for the March ballot is Wednesday, January 21 at 5:00 p.m. The last day to register to vote in this election is March 7. The ballots will be mailed out no sooner than March 3 nor later than March 9.

Some of you, maybe most, are thinking what's the big deal here. These are all unpaid positions where you volunteer your time and energy at least once a month for the meeting. What you are entrusted with, is the taxpayer's hard earned money. In the case of the Port Orford Rural Fire board their taxing district yields around \$42,000 a year. Our board has been saving most of that tax money gathered over the last several years for the purchase of a new piece of fire fighting equipment. We now have approximately \$180,000 saved up for equipment purchases.

These boards all operate under Oregon Regulatory Statutes which dictate the conduct of these public meetings. The districts are required to post in the area newspapers notices of their budget hearings and the budget figures for public dissemination. Attendance at most district board meetings is minimal unless there is something controversial in the air. One Port of Port Orford meeting played to a capacity house at the city council chambers and was covered by 4 television stations and at least 5 newspapers. Don't worry though, the glare of publicity rarely shines on the governing bodies of these taxing districts. Now I wonder if our state senators will choose a leader sometime this year.



Paying attention to your fingernails and toenails isn't only a sign of vanity - they can indicate hidden health problems.

Your doctor won't be able to make a diagnosis just by looking at your nails, but they can give her clues. Illness can cause changes in your nails that your physician can use to support a diagnosis.

Here are some nail disorders that may be linked with illnesses: Beau's Lines: Indentations that run across your

nail. This can occur when growth at the matrix (root) is interrupted by severe illness such as heart attack, measles, pneumonia or by fever.

Clubbing: Fingertips widen and become round. Nails curve around fingertips, Caused by enlargement of connective tissue as compensation for a chronic lack of oxygen. Lung disease is present in 80% of people with clubbed fingers. Also may appear in heart


