## Projects

Seems like everybody's got a project these days. Mayor Delaine Kennedy tells us she has a committee looking into Highway 101 traffic control. John Zia of Brookings is breaking ground on 18th Street for four or five affordable new houses. Many of those on the Elk River are joining in a project to prevent massive logging on their Wild and Scenic River.

Since the election, our new leaders have been talking about their new project, providing a "data highway infrastructure." I've got a project too. I want to be one of the roadside stops on this data highway. My project is setting up a *computer bulletin board system* (or BBS) here at The Downtown Fun Zone. You know what a "bulletin board" is. You've probably posted your own meeting notices, 4 Sale signs, etc. on the bulletin boards at Chetco FCU, Sentry Market, or elsewhere. A computer BBS is similar but, instead of physically visiting the board and tacking up a notice, you use your computer to make a phone call to my BBS and post your notice (or read other notices) electronically. First, lets look at how it works.

Imagine that you are sitting at your computer. You could get an extension cable for your keyboard and monitor and have the actual computer under your desk. If you had a longer extension cable, you might have the computer in another room, or down the block, or in another city, or... Well, extension cables only work over very short distances but you can achieve

the same effect by linking your computer with another via the phone lines. Your keystrokes and the other computer's responses are transmitted just as if you had a long extension cable. We'll go into more technical details of how this is done some other time. Lets learn a little more about what you can do with a BBS.

We already mentioned posting messages. Messages can be *public* - for all to read, or *private* - visible to just a specific person. If a system gets too many messages, it can get hard to find the ones about "fillet of old Gnu" among all the messages about "advanced geriatric research on Aardvarks." To avoid this problem, the BBS has different *conference* areas for each major topic under discussion. This lets you see just the messages of interest to you without wasting your time looking at all the rest.

Some conferences that might be popular here include: Local School Issues, Surfing and Diving, Local Politics, Computer Help Line, Writers Network, Pampered Pets, Ranching & Farming, Firearms, Genealogy, etc. The software we will be using allows up to 1000 conferences. Each of them provides a place for people to share information, get help, meet others of like interests, etc. Next we go one step further...

In the dead of night when others sleep, one BBS computer automatically calls another and they share all their new messages with each other. The next day, each BBS not only has all the messages left locally, but all those from the other BBS and any

from other BBS's that had previously shared with it! This is called "Echo Mail." Fido Net is a loose association of more than 15,000 BBS's world-wide which regularly share messages. Linked to Fido you may ask for a recipe for spaghetti in Port Orford and get a response from a chef in Milan, Italy or a housewife in Toronto, Canada, or ??? This sort of network link also allows you to send private mail (Net Mail) world wide. You've now gained the world by making just a local phone call!

But wait, there's more! You can also get lots of public domain or shareware software by downloading it from your friendly local bulletin board. "Won't I get a virus?" I hear you ask. Probably not. All programs will be tested before being made available to you. The risk of getting a computer virus from a well run BBS is very low and the benefits more than outweigh any minor risks.

"Sounds pretty good," you say. "What's the catch?"

There are a couple of small issues. First, you have to have a computer, modem, modem software, and be able to hook it all up and use it. We are offering modems at only 10% over cost to encourage people to prepare for this BBS. We will be offering training classes in the near future.

A second issue is the cost of running the BBS. We need to pay for a phone line (and lots of long distance charges to use echo mail). We have equipment and would

### Western Exposure

Measles vaccine will be offered to all 7th grade students at Blanco Jr. High on Monday, Feb. 22. The Health Department is having a special clinic to meet recommendations that all 12 year olds have a second dose of measles vaccine.

Measles is a serious disease which can have major complications. Health authorities have determined that measles vaccinations in infancy does not always give lifelong protection.

To participate, students must have a consent slip signed by their parent or guardian. A \$6.00 administration fee will be charged but no child will be refused the vaccine because of inability to pay.

Currently we are thinking of \$30.00 per year although we may revise this figure as we refine our understanding of the actual costs.
