Begins March 20

Clean Up by Evan Kramer

This Saturday, March 20 has officially been proclaimed Port Orford Clean-Up Day by our mayor Delaine Kennedy. This coincides with the first day of spring break for students in the 2CJ school district. Need we mention the first day of spring is on Saturday and in parts of the country winter is going out with a resounding roar. It's time to plant.

Six year old Tomas Sanchez suggested the idea of cleaning up the city to his mother while they were walking around Port Orford and they presented the suggestion to the city council.

The city is providing three manned dumpsters - one for wood, one for metal scraps and one for general purpose garbage. They will be located at Buffington Park on Saturday from 9:00 in the morning until 5:00 in the evening. Mayor Kennedy is inviting one and all to come out on Saturday and pick up the litter on the streets where they live. Speaking of cleaning things up the city has been busy at Buffington Park clearing out some of the brush and limbing some of the trees. Also, the petition to save the handball court worked. It won't be demolished but it will be painted by volunteers.

The Port Orford Arts Festival '93 is now a close seven weeks away. It takes place the weekend of May 7-9. This year there are three new locations where exhibits and demonstrations will take place. They all are new businesses and in buildings that have been extensively remodeled. There will be a pastel painting exhibit at the Sixes River Hotel located at the confluence of Highway 101 and Sixes River. The Sixes Hotel has been beautifully restored by Eric Oberbeck and Marilyn Dewitt and is also home to CB's Bistro where Christophe Baudry practices his culinary art. The hotel has five bedrooms, each with its own bathroom and is pleasing visible to the passing motorist from Highway 101 at the Sixes River.

The Grantland Mayfield Gallery keeps on getting better. They will host several demonstrations including Milton Finch doing gold and silver jewelry making in his studio in the rear of the building and Jim and Linda Grantland giving stained glass demonstrations. They will be making stained glass in a kiln in addition to copper foiled and tiffany. A few weeks back they opened up a new large addition to the their gallery. To gain entrance to the room you cross under an arch created from a magnificent piece of Port Orford Cedar crafted by Greg Polley.

The Grantland Mayfield Gallery's building is at least 94 years old. They have a photo of it from 1897 when it was known as Leneze's Hall and the upstairs was a grand ballroom. At one time in its life it was a Safeway store and another incarnation was as Tucker's Market. Some-

where along the way part of the second story was removed but the Grantland's have raised the roof and restored it as living quarters.

There will be demonstrations of pottery making at the not yet opened Port Orford Pottery located in the building that used to house Lightning Video. If you frequented it back then, you're in for a surprise. Looking in through the front window, you can see the big changes. The latest we hear is the studio and gallery will open on April 1.

How can you tell spring is here? The skunk cabbage is blooming. The skunk cabbage holds the distinction of having the largest leaf of any plant in the Northwest. Some grow as large as 3'. This odiferous plant likes to keep its feet wet so you'll find it in wetlands, swamps and along creeks. Native Americans used to make good use of the plant for medicinal purposes and food.



The Cook Gallery proudly presents the sculptures of internationally known Modernist Jan Zach. His work can be found in museums and public places in Czechoslavakia, the country of his birth, Brazil, Canada and the U.S.A.

In 1958 Zach was invited to join the faculty of the University of Oregon. His many achievements in the U.S. include, decorating the Czech Pavilion at the New York World's Fair 1939, head of the sculpture department University of Oregon, founding member of International Sculpture, publishers of Sculpture Magazine, and was awarded first prize at the annual National/International Sculpture Conference, New Orleans, 1976. Jan Zach has had work commissioned by Eleanor Roosevelt, the state of Oregon, Meier and Frank and Pacific Northwest Bell among others.

Jan Zach was strongly impressed by the Constructivist philosophy of Naum Gabo and the light concepts of Czech sculptor/ architect Zdenek Pesanek. "Light illuminating form in space with the utilization of the resultant shadows and with consideration of solid and hollow volumes as a means of expressing space.

Using the medium of wood, bronze, aluminum, and stainless steel Zach explored light, shadow and space. Sculptures on exhibit at the Cook Gallery were created from 1949 to 1974. The public is invited to visit the gallery at 705 Oregon Street, Port Orford, and experience the marvelous contribution Jan Zach gave to the arts.


