## A Visit to the Library by Evan Kramer

This week is National Library Week. The Port Orford Library is celebrating this occasion with an open house on Saturday. Part of the open house will include a performance by storyteller Rachel Foxman and Janet Naylor playing the celtic harp. The open house sponsored by the Friends of the Library takes place from 2:00-3:00pm in the city council chambers located a few feet away from the library.

While you're at the library you can check the selection of new books on the north wall, the magazine racks with 70 selections, the newspaper rack featuring such papers as the U.S.A. Today, Wall Street Journal, The Christian Science Monitor, The World and The Oregonian in addition to the Curry County newspapers.

Looking through the selection of new books I came across some interesting titles including *Genius*, *The Life and Science of Richard Feynman* by James Gleick; *Dino*, a biography of Dean Martin by Nick Tosches, *Step By Step Organic Vegetable Gardening* by Shepherd Ogden and *Shadows of Forgotten Ancestors*, *A Search For Who We Are* by Carl Sagan and Ann Druyan.

There are also free government publications available at the library including the Driver's License Manual and the proposed Curry County 1993-94 budget

which can be read at the library but not checked out.

History buffs will want to take a look at the History of Western States Plywood Cooperative, a photo and newspaper clipping album compiled by Mabel Edwards and donated to the library by her family. I saw a most amusing picture of Sam Cuatt in the album.

The library is run by librarian Bonnie Wagner and assistant librarian Pat Lee with help from many volunteers. It is one of the brightest spots on the Port Orford landscape.

Outside the library doors there are several boxes of used magazines donated by area residents. They are free for the taking and a good way to pass on the reading material you're through with and don't want to store.

Arts Festival 93 starts a little early this Saturday at the Cook Gallery. Rick Cook's

second show of the year features glass-works of Jim Nowak. Rick describes the show entitled "*underwater*" as an installation. The show kicks off with an artist reception on Saturday evening starting at 6:00pm. The gallery remains "*underwater*" from April 24 through May 23. The James Nowak Glass Studio is one of the 22 locations offering special events in next month's Arts Festival. The studio will feature glass blowing demonstrations all three days of the Arts Festival which takes place May 7, 8, & 9.



WARNING: We recommend you not use the DoubleSpace feature in DOS 6.0 at this time. People are starting to report lost data when using it. Presumably in a month or two we will know how to use it safely (or Microsoft will issue a fix) but for now, best to be safe and just enjoy the many other features in this new release of DOS. Although there have been some reports of problems with MemMaker, we don't consider them as important since they can normally be repaired without loss of data. Meanwhile, we still feel

that DOS 6.0 is a good value for most users.

And yes, by the way, we do have full time principals at each school even though you choose to call them part time teachers and counselors.
