Finally two full days of sun shine upon the south coast and out come the lawnmowers and brush cutters. Or how about a walk along the beach south of Cape Blanco where I hear a glass float was found washed ashore recently. Jeannette McAulliffe, a waitress at the Whale Cove told me her brother has found three glass floats over the last two weeks. Last time I was out walking the beach I found a rusting and destroyed crab pot and a plastic float.

Arts Festival 93 is now one week away and the town and road are ready for a big crowd. There is one significant change to the Arts Festival 93 schedules which have been printed and are being distributed. The pancake breakfast sponsored by the Port Orford emergency services has been cancelled. It was to have taken place on Saturday morning at the fire station. At a recent meeting of the volunteer fire department the members decided to cancel the breakfast in light of the problems experienced by local restaurants during the recent Highway 101 closure. They felt the breakfast would take away more of their business. The fund raising breakfast will be rescheduled for another time.

On Monday evening the volunteer fire department tested out its newest piece of equipment. It's a former U.S. Air Force jet fuel tanker now doing service for the Port Orford Fire Department as a tanker pumper. It has been rigged up with a deluge gun on top of the tank. Monday night water was shot out of it approximately onto the beach at Battle Rock from high above. It gives the department many additional capabilities especially in those "hard to get at" areas.

One of the 22 events of the Arts Festival is the carriage rides through town provided by K-M Corral. The carriage is pulled by Bill who spends most of his time on Coast Guard Hill. Sunday is not only the third and final day for the Arts Festival but also Mother's Day. That might be a nice surprise for mother, taking her for a ride on a horse drawn carriage through the oldest townsite on the Oregon Coast.

Meetings, meetings, meetings... Several important public meetings are coming up starting tonight, April 29, with a meeting held by the Division of State Lands Kelp Advisory Committee at the Senior Center in Port Orford from 6:30-8:00pm The Advisory Committee is seeking comments from the public concerning whether the state should enter into leases for small scale commercial harvest of kelp.

The week of May 3-7 Curry County holds its budget committee meetings at the Courthouse Annex in Gold Beach. Public comment is taken at these sessions. This is the time and place where the financial pie for the County is divided up. Interestingly, less than 10% of Curry

County's budget revenue comes from the property taxes collected in the county. The first budget meeting starts on Monday afternoon at 1:30pm in the courthouse annex. The budget covers the period from July 1, 1993 - June 30, 1994.

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Port Orford-Langlois 2CJ school board is the second Tuesday evening of every month. The month of May sees the schedule moved up a week with their regular meeting taking place on the first Tuesday in the month, May 4, at 8:00pm in the library room at Pacific High School.

There are still tickets available for Sunday's benefit performance and brunch at the Truculent Oyster for Hanneke Cassel. She is the national junior Scottish fiddle champion and will be performing with her mother Diane, Starr McMullen, and Frank Moore. The proceeds will be used to send Hanneke to the Isle of Skye Fiddle School in Scotland. There should be some mighty fine picking at the Truculent.

Music lovers will also want to attend the Bay Area Adult Concert Band which will present a free concert at 7:30pm on Thursday, April 29th at Pacific High School.

All in all, the month of May is shaping up to be one exciting month for Port Orford!

More On DOS 6.0

Reports continue to come in about problems with DOS 6.0. Microsoft has reportedly acknowledged problems with Sharp notebook computers models 6781 and 6881. Acer America Corp.'s BIOS versions prior to 1.2 Rev. 4 are reported to have problems as are systems which use a file named "ASPI4DOS.SYS" to support a second SCSI device (such as a CD-ROM). At the same time one must consider that more than 2.2 million copies of DOS 6 have been shipped in the last two weeks and most users have not had problems.

With any new system software, and even more so with DOS 6, it is recommended you back up your hard disk to floppys or tape before installing the upgrade. You should also know how to use the F5 key to bypass the config.sys and autoexec bat files if necessary. See pg 103 in your DOS 6 manual.


Proceeds from the event go towards maintaining the Curry County Historical Museum.
