DOS 6.0 Cure

DOS 6.0 has received a lot of bad publicity for problems that aren't its fault. In many cases, the problem has been a result of user error or bugs in other programs. Many of the difficulties center around the new version of SMARTDRV disk cacheing software.

Previous versions of DOS didn't install Smartdry. If you diligently read the DOS manual and explored your DOS files, you could learn it existed and how to install and use it. Your reward was a faster computer since the program can make disk accesses 10,000+ times faster!

DOS 6.0 automatically installs Smartdrv for you. This would be great except for two things. First, installing additional software leaves less RAM for other programs. Some may refuse to run and at least one did not correctly report the reason for failing which made it look like DOS 6 was at fault.

The second problem is that the new version of Smartdrv is faster because it does not have a "write thru" cache. In a write thru cache, when you tell a program to save data to disk, it does so immediately and your data is safely on disk. With the new Smartdrv, the program only stores your data to the cache (in RAM.) Later, when Smartdrv determines your computer isn't busy, it will copy the data from the cache and store it safely on the hard disk. This intelligent use of the computer's

resources makes for faster operation. BUT, if you save a file, exit your program and turn off the computer, the data may not yet have been saved to disk and is therefore lost! You need to wait and give the cache a chance to catch up! OR, you can install SMARTPMT which is available on our BBS at 332-0159.

Smartpmt forces the cache to save everything to disk whenever you return to a DOS prompt. Just copy the program to your hard disk and put the "smartpmt" command in your AUTOEXEC.BAT file to load it into memory every time you boot up. With Smartpmt active, it's safe to turn power off or re-boot any time you are at a DOS prompt.
