Yesterday, after going to the post office to drop off a few letters I decided to swing by Battle Rock Park for a look at the ocean. It was lucky for me, as I came upon yet another eye catching car caravan. This one was composed of 11 classic Ford cars. All but one were Ford Fairlane and Galaxy Skyliners with the unique feature of having retractable hard tops. Remember those?

All but one of the Skyliners were restored with one being in what was described as modified condition. One of the Skyliner owners described to me there are a few rare ones in original condition though not in this group. If this group of 1957-59 Fords wasn't enough amongst their group was a combination Edsel and Ford Skyliner. The owner described it as 3/4 Edsel and 1/4 Skyliner. He also said it was one of only two Edsels in the world of its kind with the retractable hard top. The group was headed south to Pleasanton, California for a car meet.

I know it rained again Monday, but summer is on the way. The school year has ended and the number of RV's, motorcycles, bicycles, hitchhikers and vehicles with out-of-state license plates has blossomed. Gena McBeth, a Chamber of Commerce Board member, and recently appointed office manager of the chamber office/visitor center, told me one set of visitors yesterday was from Germany.

I always wonder as people from out of the area drive through town if they realize some of the attractions that are not visible from a car window along Highway 101.

One area of interest is the Port Orford dock. You can drive down Dock Road to the end and see a number of boats parked not in the water but on top of the dock, safe against storms. Some of the catch that comes across our dock includes urchins, crab, rock cod and tuna. Whales have been spotted just off the jetty that "protects" our dock. Some have been so close you could almost shake their fin and hold a conversation with them.

As a person whizzes by 9th Street either in a north or south direction they may not realize what they've missed by not heading west on 9th and up Coast Guard Road to the old Coast Guard headquarters. There's a park up there with water and barbecue pits and a couple of nice walks including one on a concrete walkway and one that cuts away from it and leads a person out to the tip of the heads. It may be one of the windiest places in Port Orford, but it also offers some spectacular views. Of course if you have a dog or dogs they would also enjoy a romp on top of the hill. I've taken my dog Myrtle up there many times and it's never easy getting her back into the truck.

Some of the better beaches for walks are

the ones south of Battle Rock and south of Hubbard Creek. These are better for walking because the sand is packed harder than that in the beach areas north and south of Paradise Point. When the surf is up you'll probably see many surfers right at Hubbard Creek or just off Battle Rock.

You'll never know what treasures you'll find whether it's a float (I've only found plastic ones), agates, petrified wood, shells, fishing line and rope, and of course empty bottles (with or without a genie.) Dogs usually run free and many of us find it a great way to exercise them and us.

This Sunday is Father's Day. We'll start off by wishing "Happy Father's Day" to Valerie's father George and all the other patriarchs out there. It might be a nice day for the family to get together.

Whenever I have a need for arcane sorts of information I turn to the Extraordinary Origins of Everyday Things by Charles Panati. The first father's day was celebrated in Spokane, Washington on June 10, 1910 and was originated by Mrs. Sonora Smart Dodd. She was inspired by the fact she and her five brothers were raised by their father as their mother died in childbirth when they were young. Father's Day was not "officially recognized" until 1972 during the administration of President Richard Nixon. One person, in this case Sonora Dodd, did make a difference.

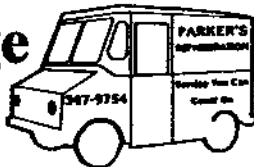

A Local Heroine by Rebecca Miller

(this letter was written about Charlotte Johnson as a mid-term exam in February of 1992. Charlotte passed away suddenly a couple of weeks ago and, as you will read, she will be dearly missed by the entire community.)

In the small coastal town of Port Orford lives a woman who is the most giving person I know. Charlotte Johnson can be seen scooting through town in her late model Ford. The 1972 blue, four door sedan is the white horse in which this woman uses to perform her activities. Charlotte is a retired registered nurse with cotton ball white hair and the soft blue eyes of an understanding confidante. She is nursing the communities unfortunate. Her time is unselfishly donated to help relieve the pain of poverty.

Charlotte is president of The Common Good, Port Orford's food bank. There she talks to all that come helping to relieve the hunger of the misfortunate people. She prepares boxes of groceries for all the people in need that pass through the doors. The parents of big eyed children will offer whole hearted thank you's or a timid nod of appreciation when they see the food rolled out on Charlotte's cart. There will even be a treat or two tucked in the boxes for the youngsters. Children shouldn't have to go without nutrition but the cookies or candy bars will make the bleak day seem just a bit nicer for the kids, Charlotte would say.

Charlotte's nonjudgmental ways allowed even the bums, alcoholics, drug addicts and the users of the system to be fed. She would not allow a child to go hungry because the parents were crumbs.

She does all this because she cares about her community. Charlotte is old, close to seventy. Who ever will take her place? How can anyone person be so dedicated to volunteer when no others would week after week. Who will have this commitment.

Licensed dogs also tell the county health department how many dogs are in your county and will give them adequate information on how many anti rabies vaccines they will need to order in the event of a major outbreak of rabies.

Failing to license your dog could lead to the issuance of a citation with a maximum penalty of \$250.00 and court costs could be imposed along with the loss of your dog should the court see fit. Please protect your dog and family members and get your dog licensed.

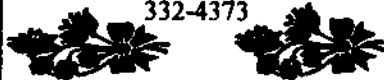
