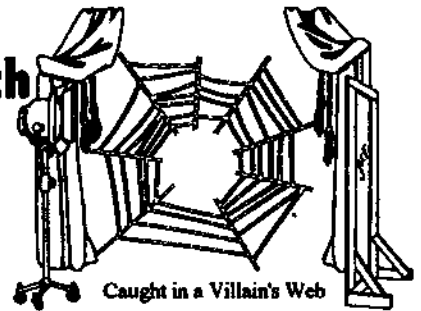

Preparations are well underway for Port Orford's annual Fourth of July Jubilee celebration. Now if the weather will cooperate next weekend that would be appreciated. How about sunny, low 70's and no wind. Most events for the Jubilee take place on Sunday, July 4th but several will be held over the course of the three day weekend starting Friday.

Something new this year is the Port Orford Player's enactment of the melodrama "Caught in a Villain's Web" or "More Sinned Against Than Sinning". The play was written by Herbert E. Swayne and is being directed by area resident and well known postal employee Michael Hall. The little theater group has been busily rehearsing their lines in anticipation of opening night which, incidentally, is Friday evening, July 2, at the Port Orford Community Building. The sets have been built and costumes are being sewn. The cast of ten players will enact the melodrama for a second time the following evening and then one final time before drawing down the curtain on Sunday afternoon. I wonder where the cast party is going to be? At least they won't have to stay up late Friday into the wee hours of the morning waiting for the newspaper reviews to come in. They'll have to wait for the following week. Of course, applause, flowers, and huzzah's mean a lot also.

Ticket prices for the melodrama are \$4.50 for adults, \$3 for children and \$15 for families.

The Steelblue Chameleon Lodge will be host to three days of fun 6 1/2 miles upstream of Highway 101. They had so much fun last year with their first rock skipping contest they're going to it again this year. They've also added a pie baking contest. Last year's winners in the rock skipping contest were Al Affonso in the adult category and Elizabeth Feldhaus in the children's division.

The Far West Bonsai Society will hold a bonsai show at the Driftwood Elementary School for two days during the Jubilee. Saturday the hours are from 10:00am - 5:00pm and Sunday from 9:00-4:00pm. There will be videos showing how to trim your bonsai, door prizes and some of the bonsai will be for sale.

The fireworks booth, which is run out of a small trailer, should open for business

on Friday, June 25 and be open through July 4.

Last week we received a call from Sue at Battle Rock Antiques about a baby seal at Battle Rock; in fact, right under it in the tunnel! The problem with a baby seal on the beach is that it needs to be left to itself. A lot of people came to look at and some had dogs with them. It's important that no one plays with or handles the seal. The seal has come ashore to rest, in many cases, and will return to the water when it's ready. If the seal is obviously sick or injured or abandoned for more than 24 hours then help is needed. There is an organization in Bandon called Free Flight that is dedicated to nursing and rehabilitating abandoned, injured and sick seals and other animals. They can be notified at 347-3882 if there is an abandoned or sick seal. The main point is to leave baby seals alone and to stay away from them.

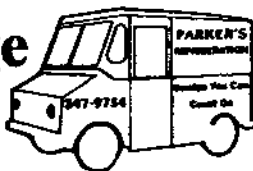

The Legacy

The Port Orford-Langlois 2CJ School Board, consisting of Merrilyn Cuthbert, Marilyn Haga, Michael Knapp, Sharon Waterman, Larry Blount, Don Smith and chaired by Frank Smith will long be remembered.

One of the most memorable events happened in May, 1993, issuing a new four year contract to Mr. Wold, the District Superintendent. His current contract would not expire until June 30, 1994.

The feeling was expressed by many people that Mr. Wold's contract not be renewed a year early.

The Port Orford-Langlois Teacher's Association recommended to delay consideration of Mr. Wold's contract until the present contract expires at the end of the 1993-1994 school year. This recommendation was approved by 29 of the 34 members.

On May 3, 1993, the evening before the fateful Board-meeting a large group of citizens met with Mr. Blount at the Langlois fire hall. We pointed out that in

the last 3 1/2 years there has been nearly a 50% turnover rate of the teachers now employed. This year all three Principals have resigned as well as several more teachers. The Maintenance/Custodial service is in upheaval. Morale of the whole system is terrible. We concluded that Mr. Wold should not have his contract renewed. We demanded that Mr. Blount deliver this message to the School Board because the children's education is suffering from this leadership.

In spite of the meetings by the voters, the many letters to the School Board and newspaper articles decrying the early contract, Mr. Wold has a brand new four year contract.

Fortunately, Mr. Frank Smith was soundly defeated in the last school board election by Valerie Kramer, but the Legacy lives on and on and on and on.

Mamma does occasionally sip a little from the boxed wine she keeps on hand, but she cuts the boxes along the diagonal, covers them with shelf paper, and- voila! she has magazine storage boxes for her bookshelves.

Mamma loves her pets, but she simply cannot abide their fleas. 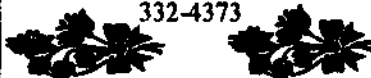

Hike to Secluded Beaches

Curry County visitors and residents can enjoy four hours of spectacular coastal scenery, wildflowers and secret beach coves during a free guided hike on Saturday, June 26.

Walkers are invited to join hike leader Brian McNulty for his second annual trek along beach cliffs and hidden caves at low tide on the beaches of Boardman State Park.

Meet at 9:00am at the parking lot south of the Thomas Creek Bridge, about 18 miles south of Gold Beach and 11 miles north of Brookings, near mile marker 348 on Highway 101.

McNulty recommends wearing sturdy shoes. "The hike is fairly strenuous, with lots of ups and downs and a little scrambling over rocks to get to some beaches," he says. Bring a lunch, camera and binoculars; wildlife along the way could include wild goats, deer, sea lions and pelicans.

The beaches visited will include the half-mile long China Creek Beach and seven individual coves, interconnected at low tide, but otherwise inaccessible
