Port Orford Jubiles

Not to get off the subject of Port Orford's Fourth of July Jubilee but Valerie and I were in Coos Bay this past Sunday. We had been several places and were headed south on Broadway through downtown Coos Bay when we passed the Egyptian Theater. We, like nearly everyone else in America, have Jurassic Park on the brain or is that dinosaur fever. Well there playing in the downstairs part of the Egyptian was Jurassic Park. The car all on its own starting pulling over to the curb but I kept driving straight ahead and didn't even circle the block second guessing myself on whether or not to go in. You talk about avoiding temptation. Okay so we're some of the few people in America who haven't seen this movie.

The theme of the Jubilee is "Blazing A Trail" honoring the pioneers who crossed the Oregon Trail 150 years ago. The Jubilee Committee has named Marie Barrington and members of the Lindberg family honorary grand marshals of the parade this year. They are descendants of an Oregon pioneer family. Marie and Lucille Lindberg Douglas are sisters and also grandaughters of Pehr Johan Lindberg who was married to Savannah Frances Lane. Mr. Lindberg moved to Port Orford in 1882 and was a builder and contractor. Some of the homes be built which still stand are the Hughes House at Cape Blanco, the Masterson home which is now owned by the Kolibaba family and the Lindberg family home where Lucille lives. He also built the Knapp Hotel which was demolished to make way for Highway 101 many years ago.

Events for the Jubilee begin on Friday, July 2. You can practice at the Steelblue Charneleon Lodge for the rock skipping tournament and, later on, attend the opening night performance of a melodrama at the Community Building.

Five Jubilee events are scheduled for Saturday and then on Sunday the Fourth another 15 events are scheduled starting at the wee hour of 7:00 in the morning with the Rotary Chib paneake breakfast. The Jubilee Parade gets started at 11:00am starting at City Hall and ending up at Highway 101 and Jefferson. The 1993 Jubilee Court composed of Princesses Lucille Beldon and Helen Doke and Queen Francis Smith will partici-

pate in the parade riding in a horse drawn carriage. The final performance of "Caught in a Villain's Web" or "More Singed Against Than Sinning" starts at 4:00pm. The ten actors in this drawing room drama have been at the community building evening after evening rehearsing for these moments and it's now showtime folks. As evening settles in and the sun goes over the yardarm nearly everyone in town heads to Battle Rock Park for the fireworks display which begins at dusk. Some of the fireworks are set off on top of the rock while others are launched from the friendly sands on the beach.

Sales of the Jubilee pins and bolo ties will continue through Sunday and there are plenty available around town at various businesses. A little birdie came by and told me there are going to be vegetar-

The Port Orford-Langlois 2CJ School Board, consisting of Merrillyn Cuthbert, Marilyn Haga, Michael Knapp, Sharon Waterman, Larry Blount, Don Smith and chaired by Frank Smith will long be remembered.

In the Spring of 1992 Mr. Wold and the Board in order to gain some class rooms decided to rehabilitate the old Blanco Junior High School (the white building). In 1991 the Facilities Advisory Committee assessed the old white building and recommended that it remain closed. There were many alternatives suggested, i.e. modular classrooms, better use of existing space. There are three school buildings and only 500 students.

A group of texpayers met with Mr. Wold in June of 1992 to express our concern about the cost/benefit ratio of this endeavor and the perpetual costs thereafter. Mr. Wold cited a report by Endex Engineering Inc., Corvallis, estimating that the structural repair of the building would cost \$33,500. We felt that the estimate was suspect because we knew that the roof above the cafeteria leaked,

causing extensive damage to the floor. There was dry rot in other parts of the building, there was an eight foot section of the foundation that was cracked and fallen out, there was no handicapped access and the septic tank-drain field was not functioning. We also expressed our concern about the safety of the building. It had no sprinkler system and heat or smoke detectors. The School Board proceeded with their plan to open the school by January, 1993.

To date our school board has spent well over \$100,000 on the building and hope that it will be completed by September. When it is finally completed the School Board will have to staff it with custodial, maintenance and grounds personnel. The students will have to bussed to music and other classes requiring a full time bus driver and a dedicated bus. While other school districts are having to close schools our School Board opens a whole building for the fifth grade.
