

I'm still trying to understand the Clinton Forest Plan, North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), and the Clinton Health Plan. I haven't seen the actual text of these issues but I've read a lot about them and listened to President Clinton's speech about the health plan last week. I don't know what the exact ramifications of the Clinton health plan will be for small businesses along the Oregon coast. The effects of the sales tax on business (if the voters approve it on November 9th) haven't been adequately explained.

The Port Orford Chamber of Commerce is attempting to help clear the air on some of these issues. They are inviting Senator Bill Bradbury to speak before the Chamber and the community. The tentative date they are shooting for is October 25 and the location would be the Community Building. The main subjects Bradbury would be asked to talk about are the sales tax ballot initiative and the Oregon Health Plan/Clinton Health Plan. The public will be welcome at this meetings. Get your questions ready.

Things are easier to understand around Port Orford. What's happening is, new businesses are starting, ownership has changed at some establishments while other businesses are changing location.

Paul and Pat Lee's Silver Door restaurant was sold several months back and the new owners of the building are getting close to reopening it as the newly named "The Crazy Norwegiaus." It is owned by Allen Masten and James "Jethro" Arnold. I got a good look at the inside of the building this morning. Besides a new addition to the front of the restaurant, they've completely redone the interior, even changing the location of the kitchen. They're going to specialize in hamburgers and fries, fish and chips and daily specials. That was Maureen Peer Oliver up on the forklift, painting the sign on their building while celebrating her first complete year in Port Orford.

A short block away from the Crazy Norwegians Russell and Alicia Ucolano from the Bay Area have bought the building formerly home to the Dancing Frog antique store. They plan to have a grand opening for their jewelry and antique store, Ace Of Gems, in a couple of weeks. Russell tells me that he has N and HO gauge trains and plans to set up a

large train layout on the third story of his building. Three cheers!

Down at the north end of town, the Western Auto Store has new owners. They are Jim and Aletha Fortner from Kent, Washington. They told me they've had a lot of help and encouragement from people around town. They're also interested in hearing what people want stocked in their store whether it be auto parts, fishing equipment or hunting supplies.

The Wooden Nickel has new owners from Powers. They are Harvey and Dylois. Johnston.

Port Orford's best and only insurance agent, Teresa Engdahl and her mother, Mary O. Loan, have bought the house located at 526 W. 9th St. directly in back of Richard AuFranc's building. They are both leaving their current locations and moving their businesses into the converted house.

Still More Mamma's Tips!

"Grape Tip" From Mamma: Wash loose seedless grapes. Pop into a ziplock freezer bag. Freeze. Take them out during winter and use as "ice cubes" for beverages and punch, or defrost before the kids come home for an after-school snack.

Representatives from the Oregon Department of Transportation met with Port Orford city officials on Monday afternoon, September 27. ODOT employees Stan Hobbs, Dale Huntington and Mark Usselman sat down at the table with city manager Dean Madison, Mayor Delaine Kennedy and councilmen George Kennedy and Carl Eskelson. The city's two primary concerns were the BP gas station and a traffic light. As most people know the BP station was recently torn down with the owners planning on rebuilding. They bought the lot next to the station and applied for the right to add a second ingress/egress on Highway 101 to their property. ODOT turned that request down. Nothing said at Monday's meeting indicated any willingness to change that decision. ODOT's people said it was safer to use the side streets for entering the gas station. Great Oregon Beach Cleanup

It's time for the 10th annual Great Oregon Beach Clean Up. It takes place on Saturday, October 9, from 10:00am to 1:00pm. The Clean Up is sponsored by Stop Oregon Litter & Vandalism, Oregon Sanifary Service Institute and the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

According to the sponsors of this effort over the last nine years a total of 22,395 volunteers have collected 334,600 pounds of trash off the beaches of the Oregon coast.

The Beach Clean Up is divided into 14 zones with three of them serving southern Coos County and all of Curry County. Zone 12 volunteers meet at the "Barn" in Bandon. The zone captain is Ruth Ball at 347-2779. Zone 13 meets at Battle Rock Park and is the zone captain is Rick Hazzard at 332-2675. Zone 14, covering the area from Onhir to the California border meets at the Port Of Gold Beach

Volunteers are asked to gather at 10:00am at the meeting sites where the captains will assign them a beach to gather the detritus from.

Some of the most common forms of garbage found on these clean up days are six pack vokes, fishing line, netting, and strapping bands. They can all be hazardous to scabirds, fish and mammals.

However, some things that float up on the shore might be considered "finds". These include glass floats or even plastic fishing floats.
