## "Trails End" by Evan Kramer

They're at it again and I don't mean the politicians. Once a year, as the days get shorter and Halloween grows near, Port Orford's very own Lightin' Bugs group puts on its annual Little Reno night. The western themed evening entitled "Trails End" takes place this Saturday night, October 16, at the Port Orford Community Building from 6:30pm-1:00am.

So what do you get for your \$10 per person admission charge? Quite a bit actually. Your ticket includes dinner featuring barbecue beef, chuckwagon beans, roundup salad, dinner rolls and dessert. It also includes dancing to the music of the entertaining group the Timber Wolves. There will be many games of chance including blackjack, the popular wheel of fortune and Leonard Foster's The Flipper. Beer and wine will be available. Tickets can be purchased in advance at the Port and Starboard Restaurant and at Association Insurance Management's new office. They are also available at the door and admission is restricted to those over the age of 21.

There will be door prizes awarded on the hour with the grand prize being a gas barbecue grill ensemble worth \$350. There will also be prizes for the best dressed cowboy and cowgirl.

The Lightin' Bugs holds several events during the year with this one being the crown jewel and certainly one of the most

fun nights out available during the year in Port Orford. The casino games, especially the blackjack tables, are usually crowded and intense. It's one of my favorites too.

The Lightin' Bugs hold this and other events to raise money for the Christmas lighting along Highway 101 in Port Orford. Come December and the crews from Coos Curry Electric hoist them into place. And on those dark, cold, rainy and windy December nights leading up to Christmas the business section of town looks mighty festive. I can just see them now in my mind's eye swaying in the wind as the rain pelts them. Thanks to the Lightin' Bugs and those people who support their efforts.

We got our first appreciable rain in a couple of months this past Sunday and Monday. So I headed down to the chicken coop for a look at just how much rain had fallen. Unfortunately I had forgotten that

a family of spiders had moved into the rain gauge. Between all the cobwebs and fly carcasses at the bottom of the gauge it made any accurate accounting of the rain totals out of the question. **Thu., Oct. 14** - Tonight at 10 p.m. EDT the moon is only 221,980 miles from Earth and at perigee, the closest point in its orbit. Unfortunately, the moon isn't visible, because it is New.

**Fri., Oct. 15** - Locate the most distant object visible to the unaided eye, the Andromeda Galaxy. 1½ hours after sunset, look in the E for the Great Square of Pegasus tipped on one corner. From the leftmost corner of the Square, look 12° to the lower left for 2nd-magnitude Mirach,

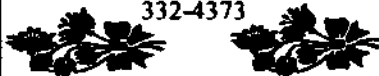

## Earthquake Preparedness

Earthquakes, landslides, tsunamis, and coastal subsidence are all natural hazards that affect the way we live, work and play on the Oregon coast. What has been learned recently about these coastal hazards, what are the implications of research to the residents and visitors in our coastal communities, what planning can we do are all issues that will be covered in the Earthquake Awareness and Preparedness Workshop scheduled for Saturday, October 16, at Riley Creek School in Gold Beach.

Ian Madin, Roger McGarrigle and Jim Goodall, all well known in their respective fields of geology, structural design and engineering, and oceanography will be the guest speakers for the morning sessions of the workshop. In the afternoon there will be breakout sessions on sheltering, family preparedness, plan-

ning and building issues, business preparations, and two special workshops in communication for local hams and emergency responders.

### Skywatcher's Guide - Continued

**Sat., Oct. 16** - Take advantage of the still moonless sky at nightfall to observe the Milky Way, a hazy band of light from NE to SW marking the plane of our Galaxy. When looking in the direction of Sagittarius low in SW, you are looking towards the center of our Galaxy.

**Wed., Oct. 20** - The rest of the week's predawn darkness hours are excellent for

viewing the Orionid meteor shower in a dark, moonless sky. The Orionids, derived from Halley's Comet, can be seen anywhere in the sky, but their paths, extended backward, radiate from a point in the club of Orion. Look low in the E at 1 am, well up in the SE at 4 am, and high in the S at dawn's first light. At the peak of the shower, there may be as many as 20 meteors per hour.

City Council Meeting

At the Port Orford city council meeting on October 11, Dean Madison reported that the city sewer project is moving along with the exception of one easement. The property owner wants \$10,000 for "diminished value" of his property because the city wants to place an additional sewer pump station on city right of way adjacent to this undeveloped lot on Idaho Street. The pump station would be above ground and thus a potential eyesore. The council moved and approved an offer of \$3,000 plus a free sewer hookup to the owner.

Madison had a meeting with ODOT on September 27 to request two driveways for the new BP station. They were unsuccessful, but the new station is being built anyway. ODOT agreed to look into changing some of the warning signs on passing lanes on Highway 101 and they are considering a left turn lane at the Sixes River Road intersection. ODOT is completing a study on the requested traffic light at the school.

There is a subdivision being planned on 60 acres along Hubbard Creek upstream from the city's impoundment. This could seriously impact the city's water supply, depending on the number of homesites developed.

The mayor had a letter from Falcon Cable TV that the FCC has temporarily exempted from rate regulation cable systems which serve 1,000 or fewer subscribers.

Mayor Kennedy would like to create a Parks Commission. The purpose of the commission would be to oversee the playground upgrading at Buffington Park and to conduct a fundraising drive.

The council approved a motion to grant city water to 2 parcels on Port Orford Loop that are within 500 feet of the city limits. There will be approximately 7 dwellings on the property and the builder will have to put in water lines and meters.
