Which reminds me of all those years delivering the mail and all the bottles of wine and whiskey the patrons on my route used to shower me with at Christmas. Tim is walking around with the aid of a couple of special walking canes.

Just as I was working on this article Valerie's parents called to tell us they had received their Christmas package and wreath today. They both love fresh Oregon greens and the wonderful smell which is part of the spirit of Christmas. Valerie's father, George, told us that so far this fall, Cleveland has received one inch of snow. It reminded me of the Christmas Valerie and I flew out to Cleveland from Los Angeles to visit her parents. We arrived safely but part of the luggage with most of the Christmas presents continued on to another destina-

tion. The closest I'd ever been to a white Christmas was an evening in front of the television watching Bing Crosby sing "White Christmas" in the movie *Holiday Inn*. My idea (fantasy) of how Cleveland was going to look was a foot of snow covering the ground and icicles hanging from the trees. Wrong. Several dates were offered - Jan. 1, Jan. 6, March 25 and May 20. The most likely date seems to be May 20 based on the Gospel of Luke that states that the shepherds were watching their sheep by night. In those days shepherds watched at night only at lambing time. In winter, the sheep were kept unwatched in corrals. The church finally picked December 25 to hold Christ's Mass (Christmas) not because it was likely a true celebration of his birthday but to compete head on with another religion, Mithraism, (sun worship) which held a very popular pagan celebration just after the winter solstice.

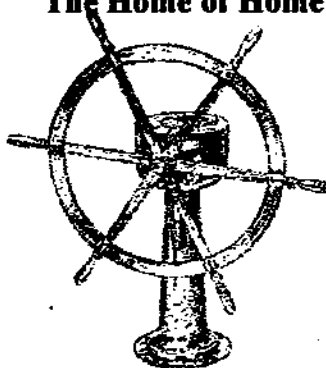

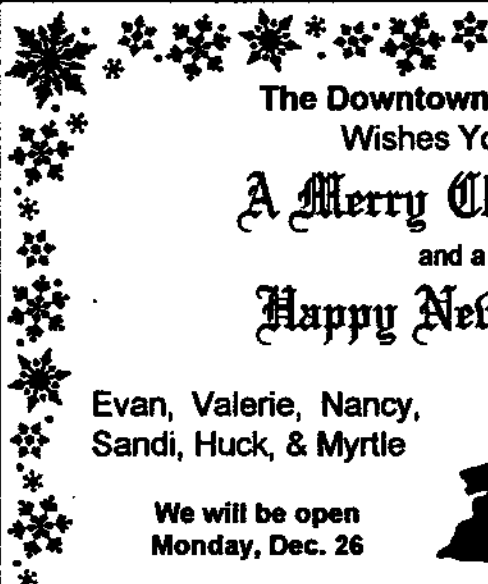

### School News by Superintendent, Dick Wold

School districts on the south coast have come to terms with their employees over the recent passage of Measure 8. Port Orford-Langlois has been able to do the same with the classified and non-represented employees, however, they have not been able to do so with the teachers union. Come January, when the law goes into effect, the board and union will no longer be able to discuss and negotiate the PERS pickup. The district is still hoping to settle the matter.

On Tuesday evening, Dec. 13, the school board passed a PERS resolution. The resolution will allow any contribution employees submit to PERS retirement fund not to be subject to taxes until they retire; thus allowing them to defer taxes until a time when their income would be less.

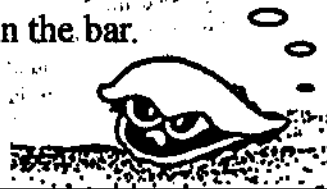

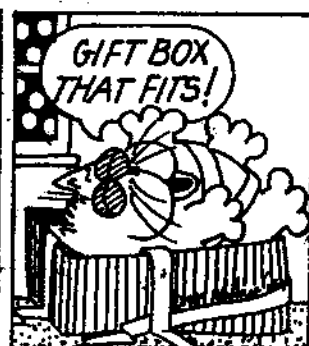
