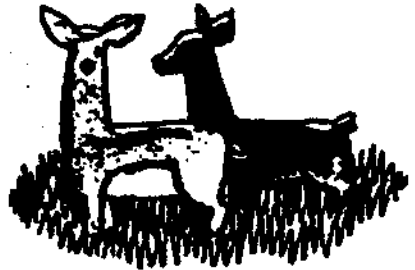

visitors to this area are the blueberries which are ripe and ready to pick. There are at least three fields of them north of Port Orford and south of Bandon where you can buy blueberries already picked or, if you want to have a little more fun, they'll give you a bucket and you can pick your own.

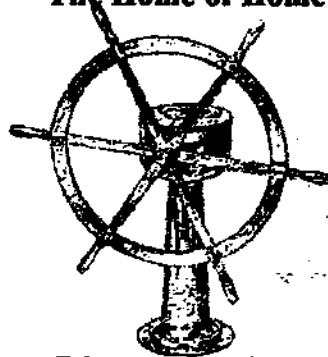
